A highly experienced teacher of watercolour painting techniques, Jude has specialized in watercolour for over 20 years. Jude finds inspiration in the light, colours and clarity of the diverse Australian landscape and has particular interest in landscape, flora, portraiture, still life and figures in the landscape with beginners to advanced artists invited to join this workshop on the Albany coast.

ROOM INFO

- Rooms are basic with either double or single beds. Shared or unshared rooms are available.
- Bathrooms are shared.
- **If booking a single bed**, you will need to bring a sleeping bag or doona. Pillows, sheets and pillow slips are provided.
- Double beds have all bedding provided including doonas.
- Towels are provided for all guests. Please bring a beach towel if swimming.

CHECKING IN

- Arrive no earlier than 4pm, and before 6pm if possible on Thursday the 13th November. A gate code is provided prior to your arrival.
- Check out is by 10am on Monday.
- **Parking:** Once on site, follow the signs to Nurse's Quarters. Follow track to the right and park behind Isolation Hospital and when that is full, in front of nurse's quarters.
- In addition to art materials & clothes, bring hat, walking shoes, bathers, toiletries.
- BYO wine/beer. (A glass of bubbles is provided on day 1 and 4.)
- Maximum of 12 guests including non-painting friends
- No smoking on grounds.

EASELS

Easels are not essential for the workshop but if you would like one and don't have one, Jude and Rob have designed a travel easel that is small enough to fit in suitcase/backpack, and light at about 2kg. They are strong, easy to set up and a treat to use.

Buy - You can buy one from Jude for \$215 – emailing Jude direct judescott135@gmail.com

Hire – hire an easel for \$20 per day (\$60 all up) and if you decide to buy the \$60 comes off the total. Email Jude to organize a hire judescott135@gmail.com

PROGRAMME

Day 1, Thursday

You will be provided with a gate code and will be able enter Camp Quaranup, Quaranup Road, Vancouver Peninsula, Albany from 4pm onwards. Settle in and join a meet and greet with complimentary bubbles followed by dinner around 6.30pm. (Included meals: Dinner)

Day 2, Friday

The Uredale Point (former Point Possession) Heritage Trail is one of the south west's truly special walks. A short, steep climb offers the most rewarding view over the peninsula, the port of Albany and two beautiful beaches. The inspiration and sketches from this walk kick off a day of watercolour demonstrations and critiques with Jude in the spacious hall of the old hospital. (Included meals: B/L/D*)

Day 3, Sat

Painting with Jude continues today in the hall. If you have time afterwards, explore the Quaranup site, the lovingly restored stone and weatherboard buildings or lookout trail for sunset views. (Included meals: B/L/D)

Day 4, Sun

Art sessions with Jude continue all day in the hall. Take a walk later to explore the fascinating historic features of the site such as the wreck of the Cheyne II Whale Chaser that sits in shallow water just offshore and the ammo shed and nearby jetty. (Included meals: B/L/D)

Day 5, Mon

An easy morning with check out by 10am. (Included meals: B)
