**Location**

Camp Quararup, Quararup Road, Vancouver Peninsula, Albany, WA.



**Inclusions**

- 3 full days of watercolour instruction by Judith Scott.
- 4 night's accommodation.
- All meals: 4 breakfast, 3 lunches, 4 dinners.
- Welcome bubbles and nibbles.
- Morning and afternoon teas.
- Guests should arrive between 3pm and 6pm on Thursday the 9<sup>th</sup> February. A gate code will be provided prior to your arrival.
- Check out is on Monday at your leisure before midday.
- There is parking on site for guests. Once on site, follow the signs to Nurse's Quarters.
- Bedrooms are basic rooms with either double or single beds, shared and unshared.
- Unshared rooms incur a single supplement of \$180.
- If booking a single bed, you will need to bring bedding – either a sleeping bag or sheets, pillow slip, quilt and Q/Cover. Pillows are provided for all beds.
- Double beds have linen included.
- Select a bed from the options below.
- BYO towel and beach towel.
- Your tutor will provide an art materials list on booking.
- In addition to clothes, bring hat, suitable walking shoes, bathers, toiletries.
- BYO wine.
- Maximum of 11 guests.
- No smoking on grounds.



**Discounts**

Couples receive 5% off twin share price. (Double bed, unshared room).

Non participating friends receive 5% off twin share price and pay single supplement if they select an unshared room.

Previous guests of On The Verandah receive discounts of between 7.5% and 10% off.

- Room 1 - Double bed in an unshared room. For single guest or couple. (0 available)

Other places to see if extending your Albany visit:

#### Torndirrup National Park...

- **Stony Hill** - a gorgeous loop walk, lots of wildflowers, boulders, great views – fabulous drawing spot. 450m, 20 mins return.
- **The Gap** and Natural Bridge - easy walk from car park with sealed road access.
- **Jimmy Newell's** - beautiful lookout, short walk with wildflowers.
- **Sharp Point** – viewing platform, worth a look. 4km gravel road in.
- **Blowholes** - 1.6km, 45 min return walk
- **Peak Head Track** – 4.3kms, 2 hours return. Grade 3
- **Whaler's Museum & Café** - Café verandah has great views, good coffee. Occasional art exhibitions in gift shop.
- **Whaler's Cove / Mistake Island** - great views and swim beaches
- **Beaches** on Vancouver Peninsula – Salmon Holes, Misery Beach, Cable beach, Vancouver, Brambles, Whalers Cove.
- **Goode Beach** at Frenchman's bay - easy access from car park.

#### Closer to town:

- Impressive, relatively new **lookout dedicated to the Australian Light Horse Brigade** adjacent to the **Convoy Lookout** and state of the art **Anzac Centre**. The Garrison Restaurant Café is beside Anzac Centre is open for breakfast, lunch and dinner.
- Highly recommend - **Marine Drive** for a scenic drive – the road can be accessed from the Anzac Lookout and comes out at Middleton Beach. Park the car and follow the walk trail and boardwalk around the rocks and water's edge.
- Feeling fit? Walk **Middleton Beach** to **Emu Point** – a few kms.
- Vancouver Art Centre almost always has an exhibition on, 85 Vancouver St, Albany.
- Albany Visitor Centre – 221 York St, Albany.
